Salient Features of Bid Document

1.0 Preamble

- 1.1 The Telangana State Mineral Development Corporation Limited was incorporated on 8th October, 2014 and registered under the Companies Act 2013 with full participation by Government of Telangana. The main objectives of the corporation is Development of Mineral Resources with Exploration and Development of mineral Industries with Private Participation.
- 1.2 This tender document is intended to give a general description of nature of the work and the quality envisaged for the materials, workmanship and the finished work. It is not intended to cover the minute details. The work shall be executed in accordance with the best modern practices and to the complete satisfaction of TSMDC.
- 1.3 The information given in this tender document is given in good faith and meant to serve as a guide to enable the intending tenderers to submit their tenders on item rate basis. It is imperative that the tenderer shall obtain and examine all data, information and particulars required for the satisfactory execution of the work covered under the scope of this tender.

2.0 Scope of works

- 2.1 The boreholes are located in Palnadu and Bheema basin in Suryapet, Nalgonda and Vikarabad Districts, Telangana State. Brief location of boreholes in each sector is given in Section – III of bid document
- 2.2 Successful Bidder with his own/leased drills or with the consortium drills and equipments shall carry out drilling in HQ/NQ size. Reduction in size of coring boreholes below NQ size shall not be allowed.
- 2.3 Successful Bidder shall make efforts to obtain maximum core recovery in Limestone strata and non-Limestone strata. In no case the recovery should be less than 80% in non-Limestone and 90% in Limestone strata, except in fault zone, weathered zone, soil and structurally disturbed area.
- 2.4 Boreholes are desired to be vertical. Bidder will take all possible precautions and skill to maintain verticality of the boreholes. Deviation up to 1° is acceptable. Any deviation beyond the specified limit will be considered as failed borehole and payment will not be made for such boreholes. To generate the required data the bidder shall do the re-drilling at the nearest possible distance from the original borehole
- 2.5 The locations of the boreholes on the ground shall be fixed by TSMDC.
- 2.6 The bidder shall be responsible for:

- Preservation of cores with proper depth markings at the end of every run in GI core boxes at his cost.
 - Sealing of completed boreholes
 - To erect borehole pillar of size 30"x12"x12" on completion of each borehole with appropriate borehole number, RL (m) and collar of the pillar
 - Keeping cores ready for geological logging and inspection by TSMDC.
 - To assist TSMDC geologists to carry out core logging and packing of cores to Laboratories.
 - To provide core splitter to geologist for splitting Limestone core into two equal halves for sampling.
- 2.7 In case of lower core recovery in normal geological conditions or jamming of the boreholes before completion of depth, deviation drilling/re-drilling shall be carried out by the bidder at his own cost on the instruction of TSMDC. However, if re-drilling is resorted to, the borehole location point shall be at the nearest possible distance from the original borehole and the bidder shall be free to do non-coring drilling up to the depth from where the coring drilling is required for generating cores with stipulated recovery.
- 2.8 If a borehole fails to drill up to the targeted depth due to drilling difficulties or otherwise, the bidder shall have to re-drill afresh borehole in lieu of the abandoned borehole.
- 2.9 TSMDC shall have no responsibility towards construction of approach roads to field sites, arranging the water supply for drilling, watch and ward, and safety of men and material of the Bidder.
- 2.10 The responsibility of acquiring/hiring land required for drill sites and other allied operations as well as payment of compensation to land owners shall be the responsibility of the Bidder. In case of Forest Land, the successful bidder must assist TSMDC in obtaining Forest permission from the concerned Authority. TSMDC will submit the applications along with the necessary documents to the concerned offices. The successful bidder has to follow-up with the concerned authorities and ensures that the permissions/licence is obtained in time.
- 2.11 In the course of acquiring/hiring the private land for drilling purpose, the successful bidder will have to:
- Liaison with locals/villagers/village Committees/village heads etc and obtains permission from land owners in whose land the drilling has to be done.
 - Arrange for proper logistic support like spare part, labour, tent/camp at drill site, lighting arrangement for carrying out the work round the clock.

- Firm up the schedules to complete all the required preliminary works before starting of actual drilling operations.
- 2.12 Decision for closure of the boreholes shall be taken by the authorized representative of the GM(M).
 - 2.13 Immediately after completion of work on each site, the Successful Bidder shall at his own cost remove all equipment and unused materials; fill in and level pits and reinstate the site to its original conditions.
 - 2.14 No extra cost shall be paid towards any "fishing" operation in connection with failure of tubular, bit etc., inside the borehole. No time extension will be provided for "fishing" operation and delay shall attract L/D clauses. In case of any loss of material in the bore hole, the details may be furnished to TSMDC
 - 2.15 The Scope of Work shall include bringing in and/ or procurement and/ or deployment of Bidder's own equipment and personnel.
 - 2.16 The successful Bidder shall deploy suitable experience personals for carrying out drilling operations as per work requirement.
 - 2.17 The successful bidder team shall bring with them, all special tools necessary for undertaking works.
 - 2.18 The successful bidder shall maintain and repair all the equipment during entire period of contract.
 - 2.19 The drilling meterage may vary due to complexities of geological structure. The total drilling meterage of the block is tentative and shall be revised during execution of the contract, considering the complexities of geological structure. However, the payment will be made as per original quoted/awarded rates per meter for drilling, for the actual executed work.
 - 2.20 Bidder shall prepare Monthly Progress Report (both Hard Copy and Soft Copy) in respect of the drilling activities as per standard format provided by TSMDC and submit to GM(M) or his authorized representative for verification and certification for acceptance of TSMDC (Annexure-V).

3.0 Quantum of work

- 3.10 To carry out 1500m of core drilling works in Limestone blocks situated in Palnadu and Bheema basin in Suryapet, Nalgonda and Vikarabad Districts, Telangana State in three months within contract period six months
- 3.11 The successful bidder shall commence the work within 15 days from the date of signing of contract after negotiating the land

hiring/acquiring charges/compensation etc with land owners in case of private/Govt. land.

AND

In the case of Forest Land the drilling work shall be taken up within 15 days from obtaining necessary permission from the Authority Concerned.

The successful bidder must assist TSMDC in obtaining Forest permission from the concerned Authority. TSMDC will submit the applications along with the necessary documents. The successful bidder has to follow-up with the concerned authorities and ensures that the permissions/licence is obtained in time.

- 3.12 Quantity of work pertaining to the block may vary depending on the prevailing situations at that time. The quantities given in the tender are provisional and meant to indicate the approximate extent of the work.

4.0 Time Schedule

- 4.1 Timely completion of the awarded work is the essence of the tender.
- 4.2 The total time period for completion of 1500 m of Core Drilling work for Limestone bearing formation shall be 03 months, including mobilization period from the date of issue of work order. The quantum of drilling may vary by $\pm 30\%$. Additional drilling work up to 30% may be awarded after completion of 1500 m, subject to requirement with suitable time extension.
- 4.3 The time duration of contract is 180 days and shall be extendable subject to the further need of work of TSMDC. Further, the present scope of work may be possible continuously or in break(s) depending on availability/release of boreholes.

5.0 Quality control

The bidder shall take appropriate steps to ensure that all the equipment /accessories materials shall be of the slandered prescribed by Government India. (BIS/ISI). National standards in the country of origin (India) shall be applied and all measurements shall be indicated in metric system.

6.0 Eligibility Criteria

6.1 Technical Criteria

- The bidder shall mobilize the required diamond drill core machines along with necessary accessories and experienced operators to undertake drilling operations for exploration of limestone blocks of TSMDC.

List of Machinery required are mention below:

Diamond Drill core Machine	5 No.
Casings, rods etc	necessary for drilling to a depth of 100m .

- The bidder may deploy five number of drills (**minimum 3 nos, of capacity to drill up to 100 m depth**) to complete the job within Time schedule.
- The bidder shall provide action/work plan for execution of core drilling work i.e. **1500 m** which shall be completed **in Three months time**, inclusive of mobilization period.
- Age of the Drill Rigs proposed to be deployed for the tender work shall not be more than **10 years** old.
- **Experience:** The bidder should have an experience of Core drilling work of at least **5000 m** in Limestone exploration or other minerals of similar types of Geological formations excluding Coal and Lignite during the last **3 financial years and current financial year** up to the date of notification of tender. The bidder is required to submit documentary evidences thereof.
Bidders experience to be annexed as per the annexure given in Section II.
- Bidder shall have experienced technical staff to conduct core drilling up to **60 m** depth.

6.2 Financial Criteria

The Bidder may be an individual / Firm / Company/ who have executed core drilling works of value not less than Rs.1.00 Crore in any Earth /mineral in State / Central Government Undertaking or Public Limited Companies / and (or) Mines of any Company during the last three (3) years immediately preceding 31st March 2018.

AND

The Bidder shall have positive Net Worth of at least Rs.25 Lakhs as on last date of completed Financial Year immediately preceding 31st March 2018.

7.0 Tender Fees, Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) & Performance Security Deposit (PSD):

7.1 Tender Fees

Bidders shall pay non refundable of fees of Rs 10,000 + GST (Ten thousand only) for tender document through Demand Draft and scanned copy of the same shall be attached in e-procurement

portal (<https://tender.telangana.gov.in>) while submitting the bid document

7.2 Earnest Money Deposit (EMD):

Tenderers are required to pay an EMD of Rs.3.00Lakhs (Rupees Three Lakhs only) through DD or Banker's Cheque drawn in favour of M/s. Telangana State Mineral Development Corporation Ltd., payable at Hyderabad.

7.3 Performance Security Deposit(PSD):

The successful tenderer shall remit 5% of Bidded amount (i.e. ,quoted rate x 15,00m) as Performance Security Deposit(PSD) to TSMDC at the time of entering into the Agreement. The EMD amount of Rs.3.00Lakhs will be adjusted against the PSD and the balance Performance Security Deposit shall be remitted in the form of Bank Gurantee(BG).The BG should be valid for the contract period + 180 days from the date of Agreement. The Contractor shall not be entitled to claim interest on EMD.

8.0 Selection Process

8.1 Bid Evaluation Criteria:

The bids will be evaluated as given below.

- Bids not containing the Tender fee and EMD shall be rejected outright.
- TSMDC shall examine the bids to determine whether they are complete in all respect as per specifications of the tender i.e. enclosed with:
 - a) Form of bid
 - b) Information about the Tenderer.
 - c) The EMD as specified above
 - d) Tender Document fee
 - e) Technical Criteria
 - f) Financial status of the firm.
 - g) The entire document submitted along with the tender should be duly signed with Seal on each page by the authorized signatory.
 - h) The bids /offer with conditions/deviations with respect to the terms and conditions of the tender document shall not be considered.

8.2 Evaluation of Bids:

Tender evaluation shall be done in two steps:

Step-I: Evaluation of the bids shall be done, based on fulfillment of technical parameters as indicated in the Tender, to examine the Technical suitable bidder will be declared as Qualified Bidder.

Step-II: Price Bids of the qualified bidders only shall be opened. The work shall be awarded to the bidder who has quoted lowest price (L-1 party) and such will be declared as successful bidder.

Company shall also mean the Owner wherever the context requires.
- 2.2 **“Tenderer/Bidder”** shall mean the Person/Firm/Co-operative/Party/Company whether incorporated or not who submits the tender for the works with a view to execute the works on contract with the TSMDC and shall include their personal representatives, successors and permitted assignees.
- 2.3 **“Contractor”** shall mean the successful Tenderer/Bidder or the Person/Firm/Co-operative/Party/Company whether incorporated or not who enters in to the contract with TSMDC to execute the works and shall include their executors, administrators, successors and permitted assignees.

- 3.7 The Tenderer shall fulfill all the requirements stipulated in this NIT. The offers submitted with any deviation to the NIT and /or with conditions shall be liable for summary rejection and no correspondence/dispute on this account shall be entertained by TSMDC.

4.0 Discrepancies and Adjustment of Errors

- 4.1 In case of lack of clarity in figures quoted by the tenderer, the rates **quoted in words will be considered** ignoring the rates quoted in figures. And if there is discrepancy between the rate quoted and the amount worked out by the tenderer, then the **rate quoted will be taken as correct** and the value will be arrived at based on the quantities stipulated in the tender.

5.0 Acceptance of Tender / Issue of Letter of Intent

- 5.1 Acceptance of tender by the TSMDC will be communicated by Courier Service or by Registered letter.
- 5.2 Letter of Intent (LoI) will be issued by TSMDC to the successful bidder and on receipt of LoI, the successful bidder shall enter into agreement with TSMDC as per the norms and conditions mentioned in the tender document.

6.0 AGREEMENT

- 6.1 The successful Tenderer shall be required to execute an agreement in the prescribed proforma enclosed as Annexure-I. The Agreement shall be prepared on a Non-Judicial Stamp Paper of appropriate value to be purchased by the successful tenderer in his / their name and the same shall be executed within seven (7) working days from the date of issue of the Letter of Intent / Letter of Acceptance. The successful Tenderer shall commence the operations within one week from the date of Agreement. In the event of failure on the part of the CONTRACTOR to sign the AGREEMENT within the specified time, TSMDC shall may, at its sole discretion, cancel the Letter of Intent or Letter of Acceptance and forfeit the Earnest Money Deposit.

7.0 MANNER OF PREPARATION OF TENDER

The tender proposal shall be made in TWO PARTS i.e., PART - 1 and PART-2. PART – 1 shall contain the Technical Bid and PART – 2 shall contain the “Price Bid” which shall be prepared in the manner described below :

7.1 PART – 1

Technical Bid: The following documents duly filled in and signed with date and seal on each page by the tenderer shall be submitted to TSMDC.

- i. **Check list of documents to be enclosed with the tender:** This shall be submitted in the prescribed proforma, “**FORM – A**” enclosed in Section- IV.
- ii. **Letter of submission of Tender:** This shall be submitted in the prescribed proforma “**FORM-B**”, enclosed in Section-IV.
- iii. **Full information about the tenderer:** This shall be furnished in the prescribed proforma, “**FORM-C**”, enclosed in Section- IV including details regarding financial soundness of the Tenderer.
- iv. **Details of machinery equipments, tools, tackles etc., the tenderer proposes to deploy for this work:** This shall be furnished in the prescribed proforma, “**FORM – D**”.

- v. **Details of similar works done during the past Three years by the tenderer:** This shall be furnished in the prescribed proforma, **“FORM –E”**.
- vi. In the event of the space being insufficient for the required purpose, additional sheets may be added, which shall be numbered consecutively and duly signed and included in the bid submission form (**“Form – B”**).
- vii. Any other information, the tenderer desires to furnish in connection with this tender.

7.2 PART 2:

Price Bid: The Tenderer shall submit scanned copy of Price Bid (Part-2) upload in the e-procurement portal (<https://tender.telangana.gov.in>) and need not required to submit in the TSMDC Office:

- i) The prices are to be quoted strictly as per Price Bid Format including other all applicable levies & taxes. Price quotation as specified in Form **F**.
- ii) The rates must be clearly shown both in figure and in words in English.
- iii) The rates quoted in the tender must be firm and hold good throughout the contract period. No escalation whatsoever will be allowed except as provided in the tender. Increase in the rates on any other count shall not be considered.
- iv) Only the tenderer who quotes rates for meterage of drilling shall be considered for evaluation. Quoting for part of the work is liable for rejection.
- v) The rates quoted shall be all inclusive covering the cost of personnel, equipments, materials and all other facilities and operations necessary for the satisfactory completion of the work and shall be inclusive of all charges for handling, transport, lead, lift, labour housing, sanitary and medical facilities for labour, construction, tools and plant, electric power and water, workshop, insurance, payment of taxes and duties, watch & ward arrangements etc., and all other expenses of every description which under the contract are to be borne by the CONTRACTOR.
- vi) Price Bid to be submitted in excel Format and not with Technical Bid

8.0 Authority to sign the Tender

- 8.1 In case of an individual, the tender may be signed only by individual tenderer. Tenders of Partnership Firms shall be signed on behalf of the Firm by the Authorised Partner and in case of Tenders of a Company shall be signed, on behalf of the Company, by a person authorized to do so and an appropriate Board Resolution showing the authority of the person to sign the tender. The Board Resolution for signing the documents shall be annexed to the tenders. The TSMDC may reject the

tender not supported by adequate proof of authorization of the signatory.

- 8.2 All signatures shall be dated and seal shall be affixed where ever required.
- 8.3 All corrections are to be attested.
- 8.4 The rates quoted by the TENDERER shall be free from corrections / cutting and overwriting. Corrections, if any, shall be attested by the person signing the tender. Tenders containing overwriting, erased rate(s) or corrections without attestation shall be liable for rejection.

9.0 Manner of Submission

- 9.1 The tenderer shall ensure that all pages of the documents are signed and affixed the stamp thereon and the tenderer shall submit **scanned copies** of all documents relating to Technical bid and uploading in the e-procurement portal (<https://tender.telangana.gov.in>) and same hard copy shall be submitted to TSMDC Office superscribed as “**Part-1- Techncial Bid**” along with EMD and tender fees.
- 9.2 The Tenderer shall submit scanned copy of Price Bid (Part-2) upload in the eprocurement system and need not required to submit in the TSMDC Office.

10.0 MODIFICATION AND WITHDRAWAL

- 10.1 Tenderer shall not be allowed to modify/vary their tenders after submission through online in e-procurement portal (<https://tender.telangana.gov.in>). If the tenderer, after submitting his / their hardcopy documents, realizes from his / their offer or modifies the terms and conditions thereof in a manner not acceptable to the TSMDC, the Earnest Money Deposited by the Tenderers with the Tender, shall be liable to be forfeited and his / their tender will be liable for rejection.
- 10.2 Tenderer shall not be allowed to make multiple tenders and if multiple applications received, they are liable for rejection and their EMD will be forfeited.

11.0 Terms of Payment:

- 11.1 The Contractor shall submit bills along with required every month for executed acceptable work duly certified by TSMDC GM (M).
- 11.2 The Payments would be made by the TSMDC office Hyderabad, after receiving the bills duly recommended by the GM (M).
- 11.3 All such payments would be made by TSMDC through e-Payment after deducting Income tax, other statutory Taxes, Levies as applicable
- 11.4 Security deposit shall be released on successful completion of the contract work in all respect and on issue of work completion certificate from TSMDC.

12.0 GENERAL

12.1 Vague and Indefinite Expression :

Tenders with vague and indefinite expression such as “Subject to Immediate Acceptance”, etc., will not be considered.

12.2 Canvassing

Canvassing in connection with this Tender is strictly prohibited. Tender of the Tenderer, who resorts to canvassing in any manner shall be liable for rejection.

12.2 Tender documents not to be tampered:

Tenderer should not alter or remove any page of the tender documents and should submit complete set in the manner prescribed above, duly filled in signed and dated. Failure to comply with these instructions shall result in rejection of the tender.

12.3 No claim for compensation for submission of tender:

For the preparation and submission of tender, the tenderer shall not be entitled to any cost, expenses or other claims whether or not his / their tender is accepted / rejected and / or notice inviting tender modified, withdrawn or cancelled. In the event the tender is cancelled by TSMDC, the tender fee, if any, received by TSMDC will be refunded to the tenderer.

12.4 Tender documents not transferable :

Tender documents are non-transferable and the documents sold by the TSMDC to an intending tenderer shall be used only by that tenderer.

13.0 Ownership/Possession of Drilling Machine & Other Equipment :

(The equipment to be deployed should be in good working condition)

13.1 The tenderers should have under their possession through ownership or lease, a minimum of following equipment:

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13.1

The Tenderer is exclusively responsible for the supervision of the entire work, either personally or through his qualified supervisory agents or staff acceptable to the TSMDC for efficient execution of the work requires it.

13.2 The tenderer shall confirm to all the laws governing employment, payment, safety and welfare of his / their labour and staff and provisions of the Minimum Wage Act, the Workmen's Compensation Act, Contract Labour (Abolition & Regulation) Act, the Mines Act, Industrial Disputes Act, Maternity Benefit Act, Bonus Act and other statutory provisions as are existing as of now or as may be introduced later as well as those orders of Government of India or State applicable to the TSMDC, and the Rules and Regulations framed under the said Acts / Enactments, from time to time. If any amount becomes payable by the TSMDC as a result of any claim or application in terms of the provisions of the said Acts and the rules and regulations, bye-laws or the orders made there under, such amount shall be recoverable from the tenderers. Any consequences arising out of non-compliance of safety provisions will be at the risk and cost of Tenderer. The tenderer will maintain all the statutory registers under the above Acts / Enactments and Rules and Regulations.

13.3 The successful Tenderer shall obtain all necessary licences, permits, approvals, etc., before the commencement of work as required under Telangana State prevailing Rules for the execution of the work and of anything required to be done to execute the work. **It is sole responsibility of successful tenderer to lay/form required road to drill site from nearby connectivity road for plying of Lorries/Vehicles, any incidental expenditure incurred and involved thereon for laying & maintenance of roads shall be borne by the Successful Tenderer.**

13.4 All the personnel engaged by the Tenderer in connection with the performance of the contract shall be the employees of the tenderer and no claim shall lie against the TSMDC in respect of

non-payment of wages or remuneration of any description due by the tenderer to his / their employees or for any failure on the part of the tenderer in the discharge of his / their obligations to his / their employee.

- 13.5 In the event of the TSMDC becoming liable for any claims by any person or persons as a result of applications of the provision of the said Acts and the Rules and Regulations and orders there under, the TSMDC has the right to deduct the said amount from the amounts due to the tenderer from his bills or security deposit.

14.0 Safety, Sanitary and Medical Requirements

- 14.1 The Tenderer and his / their employees shall promptly comply with the safety, sanitary and medical requirements as stated therein prescribed by law, or as may, from time to time.
- 14.2 The Tenderer shall be responsible for imparting required Vocational Training and the tenderer shall be responsible for the safety of his / their employees in all phases of work and shall provide and enforce the use of such safeguards, safety boots, shine guards, gloves, respirator, safety belts, helmets, goggles and other safety devices as may be required by the regulations for the time being in force. The tenderer shall promptly report serious accidents to any of his / their employees to the GM (M).
- 14.3 All portions of the work shall be maintained in a neat, clean and sanitary condition at all times. Toilets shall be furnished by the tenderer wherever needed, for use of employees on the work.
- 14.4 First Aid facilities and supplies as required by the Regulations for the time being in force shall be kept at the workplace.
- 14.5 All Equipments deployed for the work should have first aid, safety belts, proper lighting front and audio-visual alarm.
- 14.6 The tenderer shall provide his own staff at his own expense for protecting the property from any loss or damage from whatever causes, until the completion and acceptance of the work. Should any damage occur, the tenderer shall repair the same at his own expense to the satisfaction of the TSMDC. The tenderer shall be responsible for such policing of his own material, storage areas, store house, equipment yard etc., as may be required. The TSMDC shall not accept any responsibility for protection of the tenderer's equipments, tools and materials.

15.0 Penalties

- 15.1 TSMDC reserves the right to deduct the penalties from any of the bills against the contracts being executed by the successful bidder in TSMDC. The levy of penalties shall not relieve the successful bidder from any of their obligations and liabilities as per the contract. The penalties applicable under the contract are as follows:

- 15.2 Penalties in case of termination for not commencing work
- In case of termination of contract for not commencing the work as per the provisions of this NIT, security deposit shall be forfeited.
 - In case of the bidder, to whom LOI/ firm order is issued and contract is terminated for not commencing the work as per the provisions of this NIT, an amount equivalent to the security deposit can be deducted from the running bills payable to the successful bidder by TSMDC against any other contract(s) also.

15.3 Penalties in case the successful bidder leaves before schedule period or termination of the contract

- In case the successful bidder fails to execute the work completely and leaves before the scheduled period, a penalty of 15% on the value of unexecuted quantity against the schedule shall be levied.
- In addition to the above penalty the Security Deposit, Performance security shall also be forfeited.
- In case, the amount available against the running bills of contract is not sufficient to recover the penalties, the balance amount due to TSMDC shall be recovered from the successful bidder including from running bills of other works if any.

15.4 Penalties for Shortfall in monthly targeted meterage

The penalties for shortage in **monthly** targeted meterage shall be as per the following table:

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The successful bidder shall follow the **monthly** targeted drilling meterage, as stipulated in the Contract period of three months.

However, the shortfall can be made up in the subsequent months and the penalties shall be trued up at the end of the contract period. If the achievement is less than 40% of the targeted meterage in any month, TSMDC reserves the right to terminate contract.

15.5 Penalties for Shortfall in core recovery percentage

The core recovery shall be more than 80% in non-Limestone portion and more than 90 % in all Limestone portions. In case of lower core recovery in normal geological conditions or jamming of the boreholes before completion of depth, deviation drilling/re-drilling shall be carried out by the bidder at his own cost on the instruction of TSMDC. However, if re-drilling is resorted to, the borehole location point shall be at the nearest possible distance from the original borehole and the bidder shall be free to do non-core drilling up to the depth from where the core drilling is required for generating cores with stipulated recovery.

16.0 FORCE MAJEURE

- 16.1 The term Force Majeure shall mean, acts of God, War, Civil riots, Fire, Floods, Earthquake, Hurricane, Lockouts, Strikes (not related to the tenderer and its employees) Civil War, Compliance with any statute, directions issued by any Governmental Authorities or regulation of the Government directly affecting this contract.
- 16.2 Upon the occurrence of such cause and upon its termination, the party alleging that it has been rendered unable as aforesaid thereby, shall notify the other party in writing within a week of the alleged beginning and ending thereof giving full particulars and satisfactory evidence in support of his claim.
- 16.3 In case the Force Majeure event continues for more than 30 (thirty) days, the Parties will mutually discuss and decide the future course of action.
- 16.4 No Party shall be liable for any claim for any loss, damage or compensation whatsoever arising out of failure to carry out the terms of this agreement to the extent such failure has been caused or contributed to by one or more events of Force Majeure
- 16.5 Where such impossibility of performance is partial, the said Party shall not be relieved of the performance of that part which is not so rendered impossible.

17.0 Arbitration

- 17.1 Normally all disputes should be settled by negotiations between the TSMDC and the concerned parties.

- 17.2 In case any dispute / difference is not settled through negotiations, the respective parties can seek remedy through Arbitration only by invoking the same within 120 days of raising of dispute. No disputes shall be referred to civil courts other than through Arbitration.
- 17.3 In case of any dispute Sole Arbitrator shall be appointed from the list of 3 judicial officers maintained by TSMDC duly following the provisions of Arbitration and conciliation act 1996 as amended from time to time. The list of such names shall be forwarded to the party as and when the party requests for resolving the dispute. Such Judicial Officer as chosen by the party will be appointed by the Vice Chairman & Managing Director to adjudicate the dispute as a Sole Arbitrator. The Arbitrator so appointed shall conduct the proceedings in accordance with the Arbitration & Conciliation Act, 1996 as amended from time to time and pass a reasoned award. Both the parties should bear the cost of the arbitration equally.
- 17.4 If the Sole Arbitrator appointed by the Vice Chairman & Managing Director of the Telangana State Mineral Development Corporation Limited is unable to continue as an Arbitrator for any reasons to be recorded in writing and the Vice Chairman & Managing Director of Telangana State Mineral Development Corporation Limited thinks fit for appointment of a new Arbitrator in the place of existing Arbitrator, he is having a power to do so. Such new Arbitrator shall be appointed following the same procedure as contemplated in (a) above.
- 17.5 As and when such new Arbitrator is appointed, he can either continue the arbitration proceedings from the stage where the earlier Arbitrator discontinued his proceedings or alternatively the new Arbitrator may start proceedings de novo if the circumstances warrant him to do so.
- 17.6 Failing to invoke Arbitration Clause within 120 days of dispute (from the date of the raising of the dispute) it is deemed that there is no dispute between the parties. No disputes shall be entertained in any form and on any matter pertaining to contract after expiry of 120 days of the period.

18.0 Termination of the Contract

The contract shall remain valid for a period of 6 months. TSMDC however, has the right to review the contract periodically and also to terminate the same on the basis of review of periodic performance of the successful bidder.

TSMDC shall have liberty to terminate the contract of the Agency without prior notice and without compensation whatsoever in the following events:

- 18.1 If the execution of work be found unsatisfactory.

- 18.2 If the Agency is found involved in any action involving moral turpitude;
- 18.3 If the Agency's men are found involved in any action causing breach of peace or discipline at the locality/area causing local Law & Order Problem
- 18.4 If he fails to comply with any of the terms and conditions that would be mutually agreed upon for the execution of the work.

19.0 ASSIGNMENT AND SUBLETTING

The assignment and subletting of the contract is not permissible by TSMDC.

20.0 Dispute resolution:

All the questions, disputes, differences arising under, out of or in connection with the contract shall be subject to exclusive jurisdiction of the High Court within the local limits of Hyderabad, Telangana State where this contract is entered into.
